

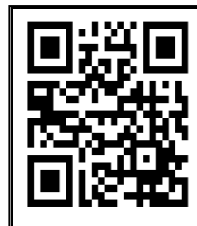

Andy Legg resigns



Andy Legg has confirmed that he's resigned as Manager of Llanelli AFC.

Legg and his assistant, Steve Jenkins leave with immediate effect.

Former Wales international Legg offered his resignation to club Chairman Nitin Parekh at half time during Llanelli's Corbett Sports Welsh Premier League 6-1 defeat to Gap Connah's Quay at Stebonheath Park on Sunday. He told BBC Radio Wales Sport on Monday night:

"I'm just relieved that it's all over. In the past ten weeks we've only trained once and that's not what we're about. I was going to resign five weeks ago but kept going. It's sad because Llanelli is a fantastic club with a great bunch of lads. I've had six great years there but it's time to go."

The FAW understand that current players are owed almost two month's wages and are holding on to the European money owed to the club until certain assurances are given that past and present players are treated as preferential creditors.

Welsh Cup Third Round Draw

There are three all Corbett Sports Welsh Premier League ties in the Third Round of the FAW Welsh Cup, following Tuesday's draw.

Wales team manager Chris Coleman and former Wales International Matthew Jones made the draw at the FAW Headquarters in Cardiff and the ex-Llanelli midfielder drew his hometown former club away at gap Connah's Quay, which is the last draw the 2010/11 Champions would have wanted after suffering a 6-1 home defeat to Nomads on Sunday.

Beaten semi-finalists last year, Airbus UK Broughton will be pleased with home advantage, but in Mark Jones' Port Talbot Town, they will face a difficult test. The other top-flight tie sees current Welsh Premier League leaders Prestatyn Town travel south to the League's bottom club Afan Lido.

Current Champions TNS will be delighted with home advantage and they will host Chris Herbert's Conwy Borough at Park Hall, whilst last season's Runners Up Cefn Druids will be aiming for another Welsh Premier League scalp when they travel to Newtown.

Aberystwyth Town will be another club grateful for home advantage, but they would have preferred other opponents than the in-form Rhyl who top the Huws Gray Alliance currently.

Bala Town travel to Monmouth Town and Carmarthen Town visit Holyhead Hotspur with both matches a potential banana skin.

During the month, the Wingmakers won thirteen League points out of a possible fifteen - scoring a total of 16 goals in the process and only conceding four. Two of their wins were against Championship rivals Prestatyn and The New Saints.

The victories contributed to taking Airbus UK to the top of the Corbett Sports Welsh Premier League for the first time in their history.

Airbus UK Broughton appointed former Northwich Victoria manager Andy Preece as the man to succeed Craig Harrison as their director of football. He then started his UEFA Pro Licence with the FAW in May 2012.

The 44-year-old former Bury boss, who scored 125 goals from 387 Football League appearances as a player, is expected to be joined at The Airfield by his assistant at the Victoria Stadium and former Stockport County team-mate Darren Ryan, who had a brief spell with the Wingmakers last season and managed Newtown over a four-year period.
