



Race for top six spot going to the wire

After a thrilling weekend of matches the race for a top six berth before the split is now intensifying.

The final round of First Phase matches takes place on the 19th January with one place left up for grabs and six clubs left in the dogfight.

Five clubs are now ensured top six security; The New Saints, Bangor City, Prestatyn Town, Airbus UK Broughton and Port Talbot Town. The Second Phase will see them fight it out for the title and European places and guarantees freedom from relegation (unless they fail on Domestic Licencing criteria).

One spot remains up for grabs and is currently occupied by Carmarthen Town who have just one match remaining. They will be challenged by Gap Connah's Quay, Bala Town and Aberystwyth Town who have two games left, and Newtown and Llanelli AFC with just one game remaining.

The outcome may be clarified a little next weekend with Bala, Connah's Quay and Aber all involved in their es in hand – and all facing top six qualifiers.

Carmarthen's thoughts will be elsewhere as they face the New Saints in the final of the Word Cup at Newtown.

TRANSFER NEWS

BALA TOWN have announced that midfielder **Mike Thompson** has returned to Maes Tegid from Gap Connah's Quay.

Thompson signed for the Lakesiders in January 2010 after spells with Cefn Druids, Welshpool, Caersws and Mond Rangers.

He's made 13 (+4) appearances in all competitions and scored 2 goals currently this campaign and will be in contention to start v Port Talbot on Saturday. Mike will be wearing the number 12 shirt.

Bala have also announced that former England 'C' International defender **Mike Byron** has left the club.

On the club's official website, the Lakesiders confirmed; "Today the Club can confirm that centre back Mike Byron has left Maes Tegid."

Byron joined Bala in the 2011 summer transfer window from Northwich Victoria and immediately formed an excellent new partnership at the heart of Colin Caton's defence with Stuart Jones, as they conceded just one goal in their opening six League matches last season.

The 25 year old made 41 (+3) appearances and scored one goal in his two seasons at the Club, but with the arrival of Tony Davies this season, Byron has been limited to just five starts.

The Liverpool-born product of the Hull City academy was once a pro at Hull City and also featured for League Two Notts County. Hinckley United and Droylsden were his other previous clubs.

"We wish Mike all the best for the future and thank him for his services to the Club." concluded the statement

AIRBUS UK BROUGHTON have announced the signing of goalkeeper **Jamie Stephens** on-loan from Liverpool Football Club. The club's statement on Thursday afternoon read;

"Airbus UK Broughton have signed Liverpool FC Under-21 goalkeeper Jamie Stephens on-loan until the end of the season.

Stephens, 19, arrived at Anfield from Swindon Town in April 2010 after forging a reputation as one of the best young goalkeeping talents in the country.

The fledgling stopper joined his first professional club at the age of 14, but has since made rapid progress.

He landed the Barclays Premier Academy League's save of the season gong for 2010-11 following an outstanding stop in an away victory at Manchester United.

On receiving the award he said; "I feel really honoured to be recognised, particularly as it was at an event with so many famous sports personalities.

Stephens' progress was hindered slightly by injury problems throughout the 2011-12 season.

"Airbus UK Broughton are delighted to welcome Jamie to the Hollingsworth Group Stadium for the remainder of the season," says chief operating officer Stewart Roberts.

"We of course would like to thank Liverpool Football Club for their support in what will hopefully be a mutually beneficial move for both clubs."

Stephens has been handed the number 1 shirt, which suggests that current incumbent Ben Chapman, who has worn the number 1 shirt this season, could be leaving the club.

The successes against Port Talbot, Gap Connah's Quay and Bala secured the Manager of the Month award for Carl Darlington for the *first time this season*.

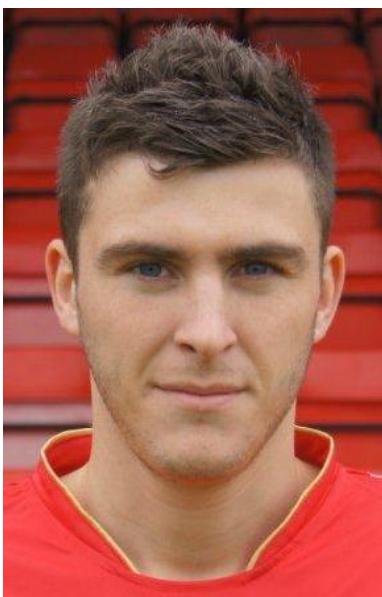
